

Images of Cronulla captured on sails

A BEAUTIFUL Chinese junk, the Suzy Wong, will be docked at Windmill Point, George Town, today from dusk before completing its tour of Tasmania as part of Ten Days On The Island.

The boat's final stop is Launceston's Seaport where it can be admired over the weekend.

The 37-foot traditional junk features a hybrid media installation and is part of Tasmanian arts company Big hART's Junk Theory.

The boat represents the iconic beachside suburb of Sydney's Cronulla in all its ugliness and beauty through moving and still imagery.

Films, portraits, messages, maps and animations are projected on to the boat's sails and ambient sounds and musical compositions will waft off the deck.

Junk Theory was first developed to create positive media at the time of the one-year anniversary of the Cronulla riots.

Throughout 2006, participants and artists from 22 cultural backgrounds came together to create a highly visible project, to reinforce positive dialogue and promote a positive image of the communities in the Sutherland Shire area of Sydney.

The event is free to the public, so grab a seat and enjoy the view from your local waterfront.
